Homeowner Safety Tip: Identity Theft

When you have to be away, have all of your mail picked up by a neighbor or put on hold at the post office. Since stolen mail is one of the greatest goldmines for identity thieves, they are generally on the lookout for telltale signs that people are out of town. Have someone pick up your newspaper—or have that put on hold too—and ask a neighbor to check on your house while you are gone. And make sure you ask whoever is picking up your mail (if you don't have it held at the post office) to pick it up daily. One missed day could give the wrong person an opportunity to make trouble.
