Our neighborhood is blessed with many good gardeners and with a diligent maintenance crew who help us make Hillcrest Crossing a welcoming community.

Charles and Darlene Snyder have worked to keep a lovely combination of color at the entrance of our street to warm the path that leads to our homes.

On page 2, a photo of our many crepe myrtles shows this variety of color shining as an example of how much our neighbors care for and appreciate growing things.

There is always discussion about the care of crepe myrtles, so we have included some tips in this edition from eHow. It may help as we prune next year.

1 Trim the crepe myrtle in late winter or early spring, when the tree is dormant and there is less risk of a warm snap that could bring the tree into early flowering.

2 Remove any sucker growth along the main trunk, using pruning shears. Cut the suckers off as close to the trunk as possible.

3 Cut off any crossing branches or branches that show signs of disease or bug infestation. Cut off

and dispose of dead branches. Cut these branches all the way back to the trunk.

4 Grasp the top of the nearest stem. Feel backward along the stem until you get to the branch. Cut the stem off 3 inches above the branch. If the tree has already produced seed pods at the end of the stems, use the seed pods as the starting point to feel back to where the pods intersect a branch.

5 Repeat the trimming with each stem, cutting them off 6 inches above the branch to which it is attached. The crepe myrtle will produce two new shoots below each cut. This helps maintain the shape of the crepe myrtle without harming the tree's bloom production.

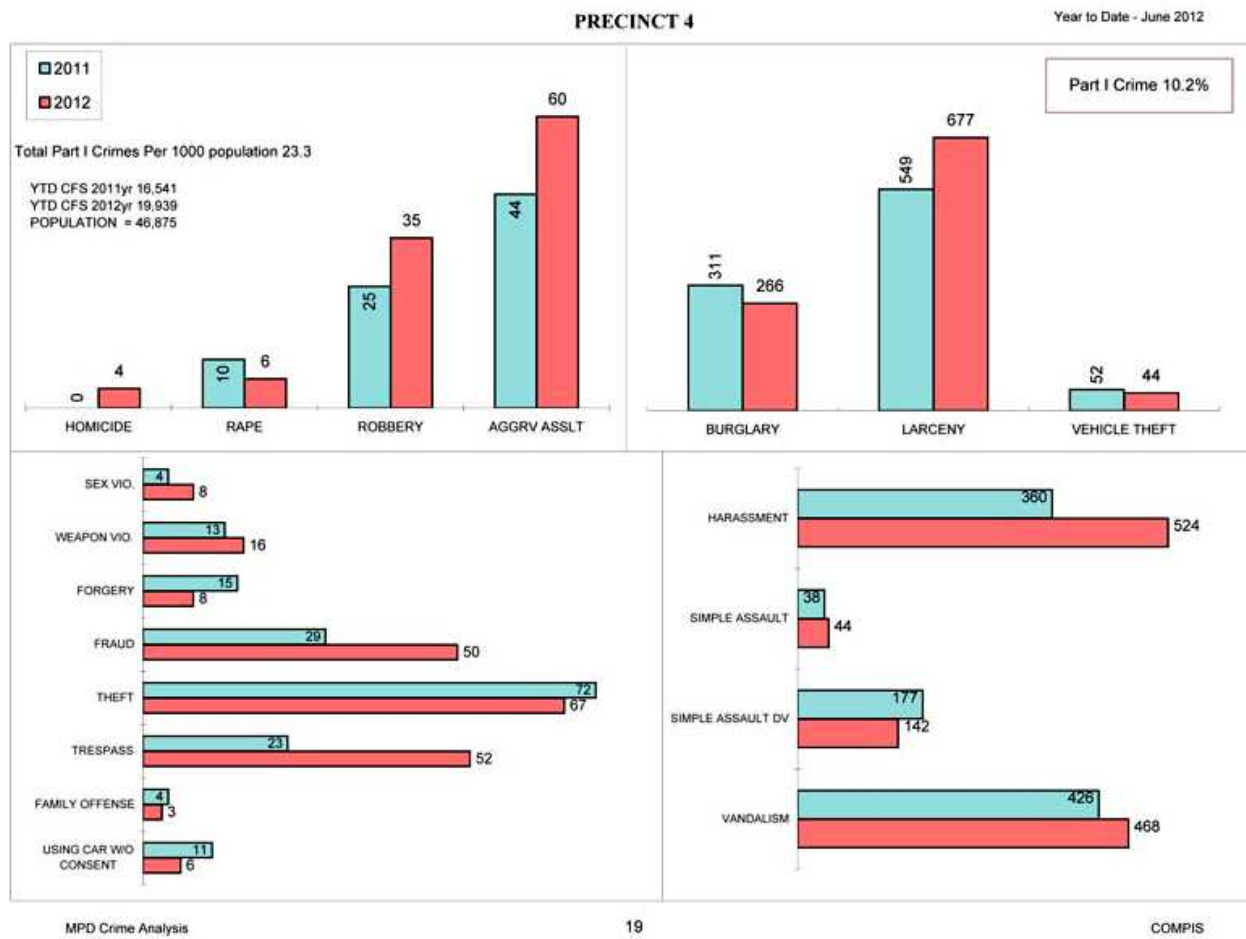

Crime Stats for Precinct 4

The Fourth Precinct, commanded by Captain Clay Godwin, covers approximately 28 square miles and is bordered by the City of Prichard to the north, I-65 to the east, Michael Blvd. and Grelot Road to the south, and Cody Road to the west. We have approximately 62,000 residents in our Precinct, which makes us the largest populated precinct in the City of Mobile. Our patrol officers are

divided among 4 squads and work 12 hour shifts. We are allocated 2 full-time detectives, which are general investigators, and 1 investigative supervisor. Two Community Resource Officers supplement our personnel by taking reports over the telephone and handling walk-in complaints for some crimes.
