



Board member elected: Dues will increase

During the HCHA meeting in September, Wayne Gay was elected to a vacancy on the board created when Frank Reese stepped aside for health reasons.

Marsha DeAngelis, who was serving a full term was re-elected to a full term. Charles Snyder, who was filling an unexpired term, was elected to a full term.

The board announced that in January, dues will increase \$5 a month to \$165 per quarter.

In order to decrease pressure on cash flow, the board also moved nearly \$5,000 from savings to its checking account.

Savings are still at \$20,000, consisting of two CDs held by BBVA Compass.

These funds are maintained for contingencies involving common association property, such as care for drain ponds and common area fences.

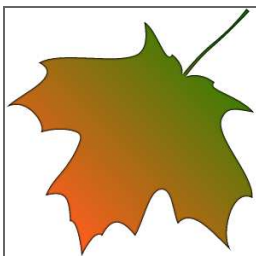

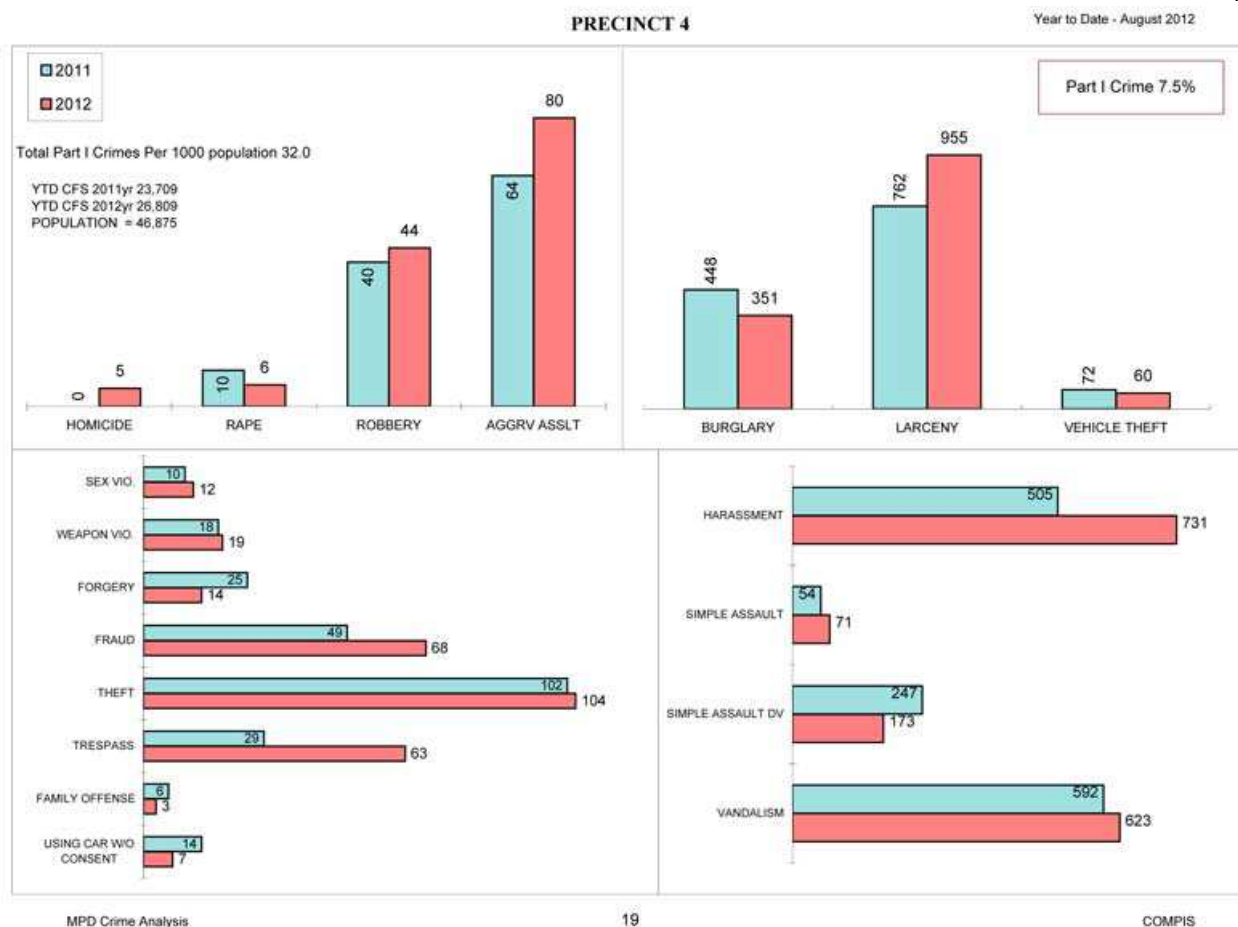
